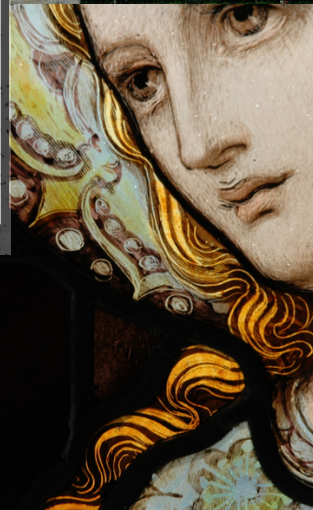
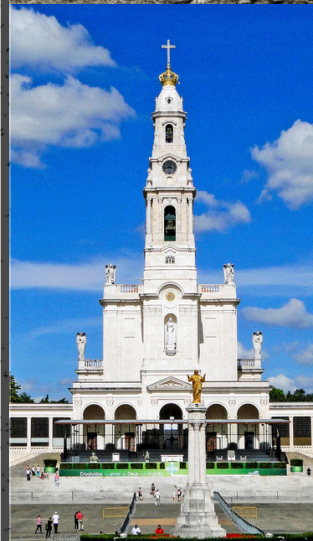

DAY 1 (11/3) DEPART FOR LISBON

Depart Atlanta on an overnight transatlantic flight to Lisbon. Enjoy in-flight meals and time to rest as we begin our pilgrimage journey together.

DAY 2 (11/4) LISBON / FÁTIMA

Upon arrival in Lisbon, we are welcomed by our tour manager and begin our journey north to Fatima, one of the most important Marian shrines in the world. This sacred place marks the site of the apparitions of Our Lady to three shepherd children in 1917. After checking into our hotel, we gather for dinner. This evening, we can join pilgrims from around the world for the International Rosary Procession at the Apparition Chapel, a moving introduction to the spirit of Fátima and its message of PEACE. Overnight in Fátima.

DAY 3 (11/5) FÁTIMA

Today is devoted to the graces of Fátima. We celebrate Mass at the Chapel of the Apparitions, the very site where Our Lady appeared. We then visit the Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary, the resting place of Saints Francisco and Jacinta, as well as Sister Lucia. Our pilgrimage continues to Aljustrel, the small village where the shepherd children lived, offering a glimpse into their simple lives of faith. The afternoon is free for personal prayer, quiet reflection, or time within the sanctuary. Dinner at our hotel. In the evening, we join the moving International Rosary Procession, a highlight for many pilgrims. Overnight in Fátima.

DAY 4 (11/6) FÁTIMA / SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

After breakfast, we depart Fátima and travel north, passing through Coimbra, where Sister Lucia later lived as a Carmelite nun. Crossing into Spain, we continue to Santiago de Compostela, the final destination of the Camino and burial place of St. James the Apostle. We celebrate Mass along the way. Upon arrival, we check into our hotel and enjoy dinner together. Overnight in Santiago de Compostela.

DAY 5 (11/7) SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

This morning, pilgrims may choose to walk a small portion of the Camino de Santiago, reflecting on the centuries of pilgrims who have journeyed this sacred path. Alternatively, enjoy a relaxed morning exploring Santiago's charming old town, with its cafés, shops, and historic streets. We gather at the magnificent Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela to attend the Pilgrim Mass, a powerful and joyful celebration of faith shared with pilgrims from around the world. The remainder of the day is free for personal exploration or prayer. Dinner and overnight in Santiago.

DAY 6 (11/8) SANTIAGO / SANTANDER

After breakfast, we journey east along Spain's stunning northern coastline, where the sea meets the mountains in breathtaking scenery. We arrive in Santander, an elegant seaside city known for its beauty and maritime history. Time permitting, we celebrate Mass at the Cathedral. Dinner and overnight in Santander.

DAY 7 (11/9) SANTANDER / LIMPIAS / LOYOLA / LOURDES

Today is a rich and spiritually rewarding day as we journey toward Lourdes. Our first stop is the small town of Limpas, home to the revered Miraculous Christ, a crucifix that has drawn pilgrims for generations. We pause here for prayer and reflection in this quiet and deeply moving sanctuary. We then continue to Loyola, the birthplace of St. Ignatius of Loyola, founder of the Jesuits. We visit the impressive basilica and his family home, where we celebrate Mass and reflect on his remarkable conversion and legacy. Following dinner at our hotel, we join pilgrims from around the world in the reverent Torchlight Marian Procession. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes.

DAY 8 (11/10) LOURDES

Today is devoted entirely to the graces of Lourdes. We begin with Mass at the Grotto, followed by a walking tour including Boly Mill (St. Bernadette's birthplace) and the Cachot (her former home). The afternoon is free for personal devotions, the Eucharistic Procession, the Blessing of the Sick, or visits to the healing waters. This evening, we may again join the torchlight procession. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes.

DAY 9 (11/11) LOURDES / TOULOUSE

Enjoy a free morning in Lourdes for prayer and reflection. Later, we depart for Toulouse. We have a walking tour of the city, a visit to the relics of St. Thomas Aquinas, and free time to explore. Dinner and overnight in Toulouse.

DAY 10 (11/12) RETURN HOME FROM TOULOUSE

After breakfast, we transfer to the airport for our return flight home, carrying with us many graces, memories, and friendships from this sacred journey.

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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TOTAL TOUR PRICE

The total tour price is based on airfare, cruise, land rates, and rates of exchange in effect as of February 28, 2026. All rates are subject to change without prior notice. Should the rates change, an adjustment may be made prior to departure. Refunds will not be granted for any accommodations, services, or events that are unused or if you deviate from the tour. If fewer than 35 pilgrims participate, a "small group" supplement may be necessary.

PASSPORT / VISA / VACCINE REQUIREMENTS

A valid U.S. passport is required and must be valid until at least May 13, 2027. As of the time of printing, U.S. citizens do not require an ETIAS travel authorization for entry into Europe, but this is subject to change. If required in November 2026, ETIAS must be obtained online prior to departure.

Citizens of other countries should consult the consulate(s) of the countries being visited to determine visa requirements. At the time of printing, no vaccines or COVID-19 tests are required for travel. However, regulations change rapidly, and we cannot guarantee this will remain the case.

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS

- * A non-refundable deposit of \$500 per person is required to confirm your reservation.
- * Full payment is due 100 days prior to departure (by 07/23/2026).
- * A \$50 late fee applies to overdue balances.
- * For reservations made within 99 days of departure, full payment is due at the time of booking.
- * Payment methods: Check, Zelle, American Express, Visa, or MasterCard (3% fee applies to credit card payments).

CANCELLATION PENALTIES

All cancellations must be submitted in writing to A Pilgrim's Journey, LLC, and to our partner agency, Nativity Pilgrimage. No refunds will be issued for unused accommodations, services, events, or itinerary deviations. These penalties are standard and non-negotiable. The following cancellation fees will apply:

100 + days	Deposit
99 - 50 days	50% of trip cost
49 days or less	100% of trip cost

At this time, the trip becomes fully non-refundable, as all land and air arrangements are prepaid on behalf of the group. We strongly encourage each pilgrim to purchase travel insurance to protect their investment in the event of unforeseen circumstances.

We reserve the right to:

- * Cancel or alter itineraries or services without notice.
- * Decline to accept or retain any tour member at any time.
- * We are not responsible for loss or delays caused by sickness, pilferage, labor disputes, mechanical failure, quarantine, weather, or acts beyond our control.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Basic medical-only coverage is included (for illness during pilgrimage). However, we strongly recommend purchasing comprehensive travel insurance to cover cancellations, delays, and other unexpected events.

Non-refundable once purchased (coverage begins at purchase).

To qualify for the pre-existing condition waiver, purchase comprehensive insurance within 14 days of your initial deposit.

Insurance details will be provided after booking. You are under no obligation to purchase our insurance.

AIR TRANSPORTATION

- * Group international flights are held for the group and included in the purchase price. No stopovers permitted.
- * Once issued, group tickets are non-transferable and non-refundable.
- * Booking your own international flights? Land Only price for this pilgrimage is \$3,799. Please advise us by email as soon as possible that you will not use the group flights.

Domestic Airfare: If you arrange your own domestic flights to the tour's origin city, we recommend fully flexible tickets, as international schedules may change. We can help you with these arrangements- upon request

LAND ARRANGEMENTS

The tour operator reserves the right to adjust the itinerary without notice due to unforeseen circumstances or local conditions.

NOT INCLUDED

Costs not specifically mentioned in the brochure are not included, such as:

- * Passport/visa fees
